

HF LuaBox Manual

1. You need to have active [LuaBox subscription](#) (30EUR/month).
2. Launch LuaBox, use your [www.LuaBox.io credentials](#) and *LOGIN*. LuaBox will automatically load into the game and close itself after you run World of Warcraft manually. See [LuaBox guide](#) for more info
3. Once in world, click LuaBox minimap icon (1) and click “Turn on developer mode” (2) to make it green. Make sure “Auto” (3) scripts load is disabled (red). Click “TypeBoxCore” (4) and select “HandsFreeBFA” or “HandsFreeClassic” (5) accordingly.



4. Click “Load” (6) to launch HF Authorization Menu in game.



5. Input your [www.ScriptVrit.com](#) login credentials (*email* and *password*) and click *LOGIN*. Your data will be saved for the next game session
6. Type “/hf” or right-click minimap HF icon to open the settings. Mouseover a setting option to read its description



7. You can add a spell by its name to given tables (write the precise spell name in the text field in your WoW Client language and press *ENTER* on the keyboard) or remove them



8. When finished browsing and tweaking settings, close the window and left-click minimap icon or type *“/hf run”* to start/stop the Bot
9. Learn to use HandsFree essential macros, see the table below:

Macro command	Description
/hf	open settings window
/hf run	start/stop bot
/hf cast [conditions] spellname	use to cast a spell manually. To make a HandsFree cast macro, simply add <i>“/hf”</i> to your regular one-line <i>“/cast ...”</i> World of Warcraft macro . You can use HF special targets @ehealer for enemy healer or @fhealer for team healer: <i>/hf cast Divine Shield</i> <i>/hf cast [@cursor] Death and Decay</i> <i>/hf cast [@mouseover] Polymorph</i> <i>/hf cast [@ehealer] Cyclone</i> <i>/hf cast [@arena1,nomod][@arena2,mod:shift] Fear</i>
/hf aoe	change bot behavior (style): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>All units</i> – hit/heal any enemy/friend if can’t interact with target • <i>Only target</i>
/hf fake	enable/disable <i>“Smart fake”</i> – bot attempts to humanly fake enemy kicks based on CD, range, LoS and other checks. Currently available for healers only
/hf dothealer	enable/disable attacking enemy healer(s) unless targeted
/hf hdps	start/stop healing cycle (if playing a DPS specialization) or assist DSPing (if a healer). Available for Paladin, Priest, Shaman, Monk and Druid classes
/hf burst	start/stop DPS class burst cycle
/hf shift [mode]	shift to another form. When macro used second time, it shifts you back to default shape. Available modes per class: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Druid: <i>cat, bear, travel, balance</i> • Shaman: <i>wolf</i> • Warlock: <i>kick, dispel, tank, succubus, guard</i> (pet types) • Warrior: <i>def</i> (stance)

	<p>For example:</p> <p><i>/hf shift bear</i></p> <p><i>/hf shift def</i></p>
<i>/hf savepower</i>	save player power (rage, runic power etc.) to reach maximum. Once at maximum, the Bot resumes using power requiring abilities
<i>/hf trinket</i>	remove loss of control with the most suitable to current condition ability (e.g. stun by Icebound Fortitude) or PvP trinket. You can spam the macro and be sure it will not waste your trinket unless you are under a loss of control effect at the moment
<i>/hf next [action]</i>	<p>perform an action. Available commands per class:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DPS classes: <i>kickcc</i> (save kick to counter any future crowd control spell one time), <i>kickheal</i> (save kick to counter any future healing spell one time) • Rogue: <i>stun</i> (save combat points to do full Kidney Shot stun on target) • Hunter / Demon Hunter: <i>jump</i> (cast Disengage / Vengeful Retreat forward) • Priest / Shaman / Mage: <i>purge</i> (spam Dispel magic / Purge / Spellsteal on target until canceled with same macro command) <p>For example:</p> <p><i>/hf next kickheal</i></p> <p><i>/hf next jump</i></p>
